## **Rich natural heritage**



#### The Region has many natural heritage sites :

- Lakes and natural mineral springs of the Middle Atlas.
- Thermal stations of Moulay Yacoub, Ain Allah, and Sidi Harazem.
- Ifrane National Park, home to the largest cedar forest in Morocco.
- Tazekka National Park and The Friouato Caves in Taza, designated as cultural heritage by The UNESCO.
- Mountains and snow: Michlifen, Habri, and Hibri in Ifrane, Bouiblane in Taza.

Forest and herbaceous cover extend over more than 1.2 M Ha (14% of the national forest area), half of which is located in Boulemane.

The Region is characterized by its unique cultural heritage :

- Fez is home to the oldest active university in the world (Al Quaraouivine).
- 6 historic medinas representing a significant built heritage. The Medina of Fez, spread over an area of 280 Ha. It's a UNESCO world heritage site since 1981, considered as one of the oldest medinas in Morocco. It is also one of the largest pedestrian areas in the world, with over 10,000 alleys.
- Presence of a Roman archaeological site (Volubilis) near Meknes and Moulay Idriss Zerhoun.

The Region stands out for its exceptional artistic immaterial capital of a great diversity : The Fez Festival of World Sacred Music, the Cherry Festival, the Poetry Festival, SIAM (International Agricultural Show of Morocco), and National Crafts and Leather Fair







The Region positions itself as a top golf destination :

- Royal Golf de Meknès: 9 holes, night playable
- Michlifen Golf & Country Club: Africa's first mountain course designed by Jack Nicklaus, voted Best Golf Hotel in Morocco in 2019 at the prestigious World Golf Awards.

The Region is developing its tourist infrastructure, through the creation of a tourist zone "OUED FES" to facilitate the establishment of tourist complexes.

The region is an artistic hub hosting numerous events and meetings of national and international renown, with more than 30 festivals organized annually (including the Sefrou cherry festival, listed by UNESCO).

The region is characterized by the diversity and richness of its tourist products:

- Mountain tourism in the province of Ifrane (70% forested area)
- Rural tourism through the organization of rural tours, particularly in the provinces of Taza and Boulemane
- Spa tourism in the province of Moulay Yacoub, which has several high-quality spa resorts (Vichy)
- Spiritual tourism through the pilgrimage to the Zaouia Tijania, which has nearly 200 million pilgrims worldwide
- Cultural tourism through visits to numerous monuments and historic cities (Fez, Meknes, Volubilis, etc.)






## **Distribution of hotel establishments** by Prefecture/Province (2019)
